



Judge Memorial Catholic High School Centennial Scholarship

In honor of Judge Memorial's Centennial Celebration, we are excited to offer four merit-based awards to members of the Class of 2028. These students will be selected based on the achievements they have already displayed in their academic, social, physical, and spiritual growth. These growth areas directly represent Judge Memorial's charism of Cura Personalis, or care for the whole person.

Each award is valued at \$20,000!

Scholarship Details

The Centennial Scholarship will be distributed evenly over four years, with students receiving \$5,000 each year towards the cost of tuition. Once at Judge, students will be expected to maintain good academic and behavioral standing in order for the scholarship to be renewed each year. The award is only applicable for full-time students enrolled at Judge Memorial, and must be used in consecutive years.

Qualifications

In order to be eligible for the Centennial Scholarship, students must successfully complete the eighth grade at an accredited school in Utah.

Application Requirements

To apply for the Centennial Scholarship, students must also apply for admission to Judge Memorial by the priority deadline of January 21, 2024. A full scholarship application must be received online by January 23, 2024.

Selection Process

A review of all scholarship applications will be conducted between January 24 and February 5, with invitations extended to finalists by February 6. Finalist interviews will be conducted February 12-16, and scholarship notifications will be sent at the end of February.

Finalists will be selected based on the cumulative growth and achievement described in their scholarship application.

Renewal Details

In order for an incoming student to receive \$5,000 for their freshman year, students must complete priority placement testing and registration. The family must also complete a tuition contract and payment agreement no later than March 31, 2024.



In order for a rising freshman to receive \$5,000 towards their sophomore year, students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better and be in good disciplinary standing. Freshman students who achieve a GPA between 3.0-3.49 will be awarded \$3,000 toward their sophomore year, and students who achieve a GPA between 2.5-2.99 will be awarded \$1,000.

After the freshman year, students will be eligible to receive the equivalent award amount based on their cumulative GPA at the end of their sophomore and junior year.

In addition to the above expectations, students will be asked to reflect on their growth at the end of each school year. These reflections will be facilitated by the Scholarship Committee, and will be either written or in-person.

2.5-2.99	\$1,000

Application of Funds

The Centennial Scholarship will be awarded through a reduction of the student's cost of tuition at the beginning of each school year's payment cycle. No monies will be distributed directly to the student or family. The Centennial Scholarship is only applicable towards tuition, and cannot be used towards other costs. Students may also receive a financial aid award in addition to the Centennial Scholarship, however no award will exceed the cost of tuition.
